IMPROVEMENT PROJECT: *SPRING LAKE (LAKE 11) AND EAST LAKE (LAKE 31)*

September 2020

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The City of Naples is finalizing project plans to improve the water quality of Spring and East Lakes and improve the lakes' health, functionality, and aesthetics for the surrounding community. The functions of Spring Lake include storing and directing stormwater to East Lake which then discharges into Naples Bay. Both lakes also mitigate flooding during rainfall events and reduce the discharge of pollutants to Naples Bay. Each of these functions are expected to be enhanced with this project by removing sediment from the lake bottoms and implementing other best management practices.

In July, a newsletter was sent to property owners and interested parties summarizing the project and residents were directed to the website to view a video and provide comments on the

proposed plans. Overall comments were supportive of the project. The project team received several comments opposing the proposed floating islands. **The City has decided to remove the floating islands from the project.** In addition, there was support for keeping the fountain in Spring Lake which will remain. The updated planting plans are on the project website.

The design plans for East Lake have changed to better accommodate the potential volumes from storms that could collect within the system. It is still designed to be a shallow treatment wetland planted with a variety of aquatic and shoreline vegetation. Plans now include two deeper areas in the center, two overflow structures, and two aerators. An open-water channel is still proposed to allow flows to bypass planted areas in high rainfall events.

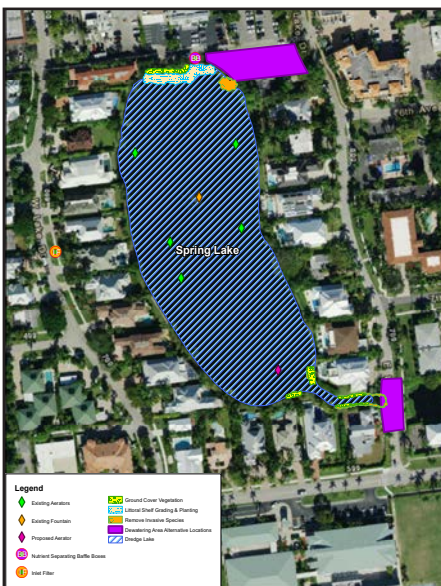
WE WANT YOUR INPUT
